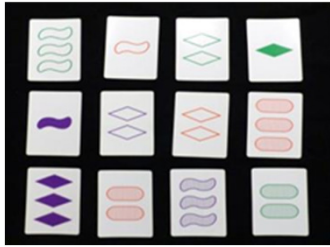


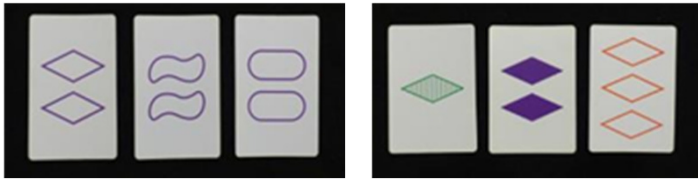
# SET

## RULES

1. Place 12 cards in a 4 by 3 rectangle so all players can see the cards.



2. Players race to be the first to make a set. A set is made up of 3 cards, which each individual attribute is either all the same or all different across the 3 cards.



3. The player calls “set” and explains why the three cards create a set. The player keeps the set.

4. Place 3 new cards on the table and continue play.

5. The game ends when the cards run out or no sets can be made.

6. GOAL: The winner is the person with the most sets.

## THINK ABOUT WHILE YOU'RE PLAYING

First, spend some time **exploring** the game!

Then, consider some of the following questions:

- \*What card do you look at first?
- \*When you have 2 cards that might make a set, how do you find the third card?
- \*What are the easiest sets to make?
- \*What's one good idea you shared with your partner?
- \*How can another player convince you they have a set?
- \*Did your strategy change during the game?

1. What makes up a deck of cards for SET?
2. How do you prove to the other players that there is no set in a group of 12 cards?
