RULES

1. Set up the base of the board.
2. Choose a shape/color - Os/white or Xs/red - and
collect the playing pieces.
3. The player with the Xs goes first. Players take turns
adding their pieces to the board.
4. The maximum height of a stack is four pieces.
5. GOAL: The winner is the person who gets four of their
pieces in a row - horizontally, vertically or diagonally!
Using the black blocker pieces:
*You can only use a black piece to block an opponent's
immediate win.
*You must use it before taking your regular turn. Then
take you regular turn (almost like 2 turns in a row).
*Each player gets one blocker.
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## THINK ABOUT WHILE YOU'RE PLAYING

First, spend some time exploring the game!

Then, consider some of the following questions:
*Is it better to be the first or second player?
*How did you figure out your next move?
*What's one good idea you shared with your partner?
*What did you do to not give your opponent an advantage?
*How are Gobblet Gobblers and Tic Stac Toe alike and different?
*What new strategies did you need to use in order to win?

## EXTRA CHALLENGE

1. What are all the unique opening moves for the first player?
2. Is there a way to set up 3 different ways to win?
